Then, press the "read" button on the scanner to access the check engine light code. The code will be a series of letters and numbers.

Watch the Check Engine Light. The O2 sensor's job is to tell the ECU when the Air/Fuel mixture is lean and when it's rich. Like balancing a broom by the handle, it has to bounce back and forth between Lean and Rich very quickly to keep the engine running at the optimal air/fuel mixture. When the CEL is ON, it's indicating a Rich condition.
